

Care Resource Community Health Centers \$171.5 Million Economic Impact

Florida's Community Health Centers (CHCs or FQHCs) have provided high quality, comprehensive primary care services in medically underserved communities for more than 50 years. Florida's 50 FQHCs treat 1.6 million patients at about 650 locations statewide, including dozens of mobile units.

Care Resource Community Health Centers, Inc. operates six locations across Miami-Dade and Broward Counties. These sites provided 87,500 visits to about 21,000 unduplicated patients in 2020 – of which 87% of patients reporting incomes were at or below 200% of the poverty level and two-thirds either had no insurance or were enrolled in Medicaid.

Care Resource Community Health Centers Economic Impact 2016 - 2020




Using IMPLAN modeling software that is adjusted for COVID impacts, the Florida Association of Community Health Centers (FACHC), the state primary care association, has determined the overall economic impact of Care Resource Community Health Centers in 2020 was \$171.5 million.

There is a return on investment of 183% for each \$1.00 invested in this Care Resource CHCs.

Care Resource accounted for 883 jobs in 2020 throughout their service area, providing for jobs both at the Center and throughout the neighborhoods and communities in which they are located. In addition to the 364 CHC positions (direct jobs), 519 additional indirect/induced jobs are sustained as a result of activity generated by the Center and staff.

Care Resource is a 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization and a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) with four (4) locations located in Midtown Miami, Little Havana, Miami Beach, and Fort Lauderdale.
