Healthcare Safety Net


Care Resource is a healthcare safety net for 1.5 million low-income, uninsured, and underinsured individuals in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties.




Benefits To Economic Health Of Community

are Resource created an overall economic impact in 2020 of \$171.5 million, according to the state Primary Care Association. There is a return on investment of 183% for each \$1.00 invested in Care Resource.

Care Resource accounted for 883 jobs in 2020 throughout its service area, providing jobs both at the health centers and throughout the neighborhoods and communities where they are located.

In addition to 364 CHC direct jobs, 519 additional indirect/induced jobs are sustained as a result of activity generated by Care Resource and its staff.
