
Care Resource is a healthcare safety net for 1.5 million low-income, uninsured, and underinsured individuals in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties.




87% of Care Resource patients report incomes at or below 200% of the poverty level and 66% either had no insurance or were enrolled in Medicaid.




### Benefits To Economic Health Of Community

Care Resource accounted for 883 jobs in 2020 throughout its service area, providing jobs both at the health centers and throughout the neighborhoods and communities where they are located.

In addition to 364 CHC direct jobs, 519 additional indirect/induced jobs are sustained as a result of activity generated by Care Resource and its staff.
