

2023 Economic Impact

Florida's Community Health Centers (CHCs or FQHCs) have provided high-quality, comprehensive primary care services in medically underserved communities for over 50 years. Florida's 54 FQHCs treat 1.8 million patients at more than 800 locations statewide, including mobile units and school-based locations.

Care Resource Community Health Centers, Inc. has operated for 40 years and has four (4) locations and four (4) mobile health units in the Miami-Dade and Broward Counties. These locations provided 109,234 visits to 23,348 unduplicated patients in 2023 - of which more than 60% of the patients reported incomes at or below 200% of the poverty level, and more than half were without insurance or enrolled in Medicaid.

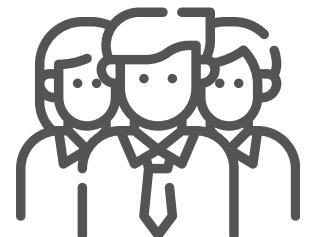

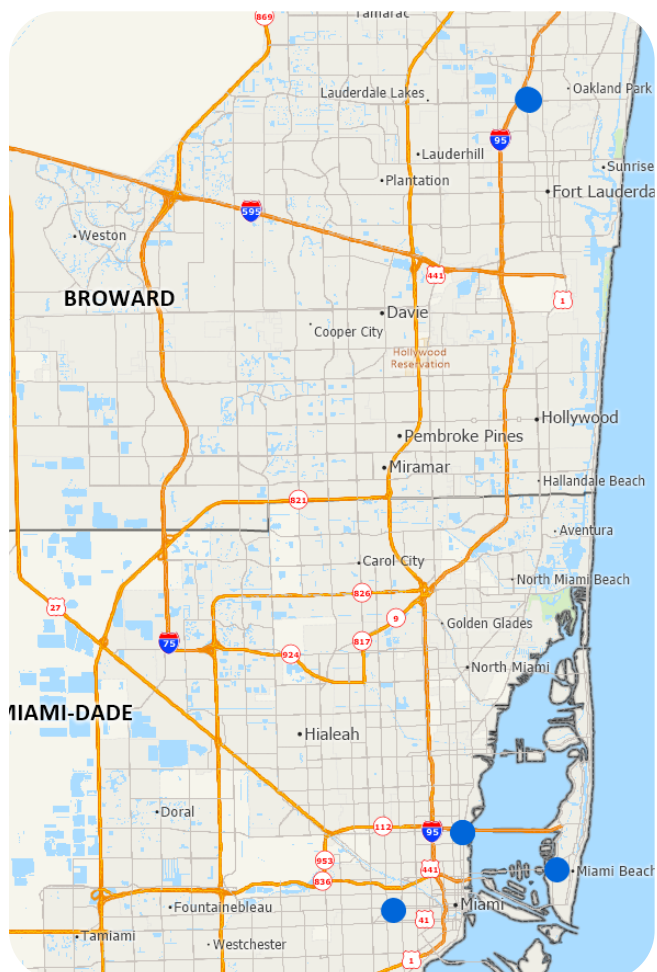
